

ADAPTIVE SOCCER PHOTOGRAPH AND MEDIA RELEASE

Enhanced Privacy Consent for the Adaptive Soccer Program

How this document works: This release is presented to all parents and legal guardians as part of the Cupertino FC Adaptive Soccer registration form. You will be asked to choose one of three consent levels described below. Your choice will not affect your child's eligibility or experience in the program. We take privacy in this program especially seriously and will always respect your family's preferences.

WHY THIS RELEASE IS DIFFERENT

We understand that many families in our Adaptive Soccer program have personal, medical, or privacy reasons for wanting to carefully control how their child's image is used. Some families are proud to share their child's participation, while others prefer complete privacy. Both are equally respected. Unlike our standard programs, the Adaptive Soccer photo release offers three levels of consent so you can choose exactly what is comfortable for your family.

CONSENT OPTIONS

Option A: Full Consent. I grant Cupertino FC permission to photograph and/or video-record Player during Adaptive Soccer activities and to use these images for: the club website, social media accounts (Instagram, Facebook), newsletters, email communications, promotional flyers and brochures, presentations, and grant applications or reports to funders. Images may include Player's first name (never last name or identifying information about Player's diagnosis or condition). I understand that images posted online may be publicly viewable.

Option B: Limited Consent (Internal Use Only). I grant Cupertino FC permission to photograph and/or video-record Player during Adaptive Soccer activities, but these images may only be used for: internal Cupertino FC communications (e.g., emails to current program families), grant applications or reports to funders (not published publicly), and training materials for volunteer buddies (shown only during in-person training, not distributed). Images will NOT be posted on the website, social media, or any publicly accessible platform.

Option C: No Consent. I do NOT grant permission for Cupertino FC to photograph, video-record, or use any images of Player. Cupertino FC will make reasonable efforts to ensure Player is not included in any photographs or recordings. I understand that Cupertino FC cannot guarantee Player will not appear incidentally in wide-angle group photographs, but such images will not be used if Player is identifiable.

RESTRICTIONS THAT APPLY TO ALL OPTIONS

Regardless of the consent level chosen, Cupertino FC will **never**:

- Disclose Player's diagnosis, medical condition, or disability status in any caption, description, or accompanying text
- Use Player's last name or any personally identifying information beyond first name
- Sell, license, or provide Player's image to any third party
- Use Player's image in paid advertising without separate, additional written consent
- Frame images in a manner that is pitying, demeaning, or that positions Player as an object of sympathy rather than an athlete

NOTE ON VOLUNTEER PHOTOGRAPHS

Volunteers will not photograph, video-record, or post images of any Adaptive Soccer player. All photography is managed exclusively by designated Cupertino FC staff. If a volunteer wishes to take a personal photo (e.g., a group shot with their buddy), they must obtain permission directly from the player's parent or guardian, in person, at the time of the request.

WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT

You may change your consent level or withdraw consent entirely at any time by emailing admin@cupertinofc.org. Upon receiving your request, Cupertino FC will update your preferences and make reasonable efforts to remove Player's image from club-controlled platforms if applicable. Images already printed or shared by third parties prior to withdrawal cannot be recalled.

DURATION

This consent remains in effect for the duration of Player's participation in the Adaptive Soccer program, and for one (1) year following Player's last date of participation, unless withdrawn earlier.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Governing Law. This release shall be governed by the laws of California. **Severability.** If any provision is held invalid, the remaining provisions remain in full force and effect.
