

PHOTOGRAPH AND VIDEO RELEASE

Consent for Use of Player Images in Club Communications

How this document works: This release is presented to all parents and legal guardians as part of the Cupertino FC tryout registration form at cupertinofc.org. You will be asked to indicate whether you consent or do not consent to photo and video use as described below. Your consent choice will not affect your child's eligibility to participate in tryouts or any Cupertino FC program.

GRANT OF PERMISSION

By consenting to this release, I, the undersigned parent or legal guardian ("Parent") of the player identified on the tryout registration form ("Player"), grant Cupertino Sports and Education Inc., d/b/a Cupertino FC ("Cupertino FC"), and its authorized representatives permission to photograph and/or record video of Player during tryouts, practices, games, camps, and other club-related activities ("Activities").

PERMITTED USES

I consent to Cupertino FC's use of such photographs and video recordings for the following non-commercial, club-related purposes:

- Club website content (cupertinofc.org)
- Club social media accounts (including Instagram and Facebook)
- Club newsletters and email communications
- Promotional flyers, brochures, and printed materials distributed by the club
- Presentations at club events or community meetings

RESTRICTIONS ON USE

This consent does **not** extend to the sale or licensing of Player's image to any third party, or to the use of Player's image in paid third-party advertising or commercial endorsements. If Cupertino FC wishes to use Player's image in paid advertising (for example, paid social media advertisements or print ads), Cupertino FC will seek separate, additional written consent from the Parent before any such use.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

I understand that photographs and video recordings may be publicly viewable on the internet, including on social media platforms where content may be shared, reposted, or redistributed by third parties beyond Cupertino FC's control. I waive any right to inspect or approve the finished images, the context in which they are used, or any accompanying text or captions, and I release Cupertino FC and the Released Parties (as defined in the Tryout Participation Agreement) from any claims arising from such use. No compensation will be provided for the use of Player's image under this release.

VOLUNTARY CONSENT AND RIGHT TO OPT OUT

This consent is entirely voluntary. Choosing not to consent will have **no effect** on Player's eligibility for tryouts, team placement, or participation in any Cupertino FC program. If you previously consented and wish to withdraw your consent, you may do so at any time by sending a written request to admin@cupertinofc.org. Upon receiving your request, Cupertino FC will make reasonable efforts to remove Player's image from club-controlled platforms going forward. Please note that we cannot recall images that have already been published, printed, or shared by third parties prior to your withdrawal.

DURATION

This consent remains in effect for the duration of Player's participation in Cupertino FC programs, and for a period of two (2) years following Player's last date of participation, unless withdrawn earlier as described above. Images used in printed materials prior to withdrawal or expiration may remain in circulation.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Governing Law. This release shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
Severability. If any provision of this release is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
